



## Grades 9-12: Using In-Progress (IP) in the PowerSchool Student-Parent Portal:

### Students/Families:

As teachers and students transition to a distant learning environment, the practice of communicating student learning and progress continues with students and parents/guardians. One of these ways is through the use of the PowerSchool Student-Parent Portal. **At this time, the in-progress percentage mark will be disabled in the Portal and In-Progress (IP) will be appear.**

- The use of In-Progress (IP) in the PowerSchool Student-Parent Portal focuses on student learning along with participation and completion of provided learning opportunities and assignments.
- Progress can be determined by viewing learning over time. The student is able to see their current performance in a comparison to previous performance to identify growth as well as identify student work which could be re-submitted using feedback provided by the teacher to improve.
