Are There Differences in How Lettuce Genotypes Respond to Light Sources?

Abstract: The effect of lettuce genotype and lighting source was studied. Five

genotypes of lettuce were planted under either LED or fluorescent lights. There were significant genotype by light source interactions noted in 25 day leaf counts and leaf size. There were significant colour differences in the leaves. There were interesting trends in chlorophyll levels. Lettuce genotypes perform differently under fluorescent and LED light sources.
